## **WHAT IS YU UWAA?**

YuuWaa is an online storage and backup solution that enables users to create their personal *DigitalData Universe* by providing them an online location to securely access, backup and organize data from a variety of devices such as drives, PC and smart phones.

## **INTRODUCTION TO YU UWAA ON ANDROID PLATFORM**

YuuWaa offers an online storage for you to share your digital data anytime, anywhere from your Android mobile equipments. With YuuWaa, you have complete privacy and sharing control of your centralized data in one place. YuuWaa for Android is available in English, French, German, Spanish, Traditional and Simplified Chinese.

## **PREREQUISITES**

This user guide assumes that you are familiar with the Android platform. For more information, you may refer to the documentation of your mobile equipment.

## **KEY FEATURES**

### **Security**

The communication between YuuWaa Android application and YuuWaa server is secured using SSL Verisign-signed certificate, hence all the data exchanged are encrypted.

By default, all the data stored in YuuWaa will not be accessible by other people. The data is available for access to others only when the YuuWaa user shares with them.

The user account is protected by a user name (which is an email address) and password.

### **Complete Privacy and Sharing Control**

Depending on the users you want to share with, YuuWaa's data sharing capability is completely under your control at all times. In addition, you have the option to apply password protection on the file to be shared.

### **Easy Usage**

YuuWaa requires only a simple installation and is ready to use immediately. If you wish to restore YuuWaa on another mobile equipment, simply install the YuuWaa application, log into your account and connect to access your online documents.

## **File Accessibility**

Access all your files from any computer with an Internet connection wherever you are. YuuWaa allows you to play music, video, viewing and editing of documents online.

## **SYSTEM REQUIREMENTS**

### **Supported Operating System**

Android 2.1 and later

### **Supported Media Formats**

The media formats supported by YuuWaa are dependent on the capability of the mobile equipments and other applications installed.

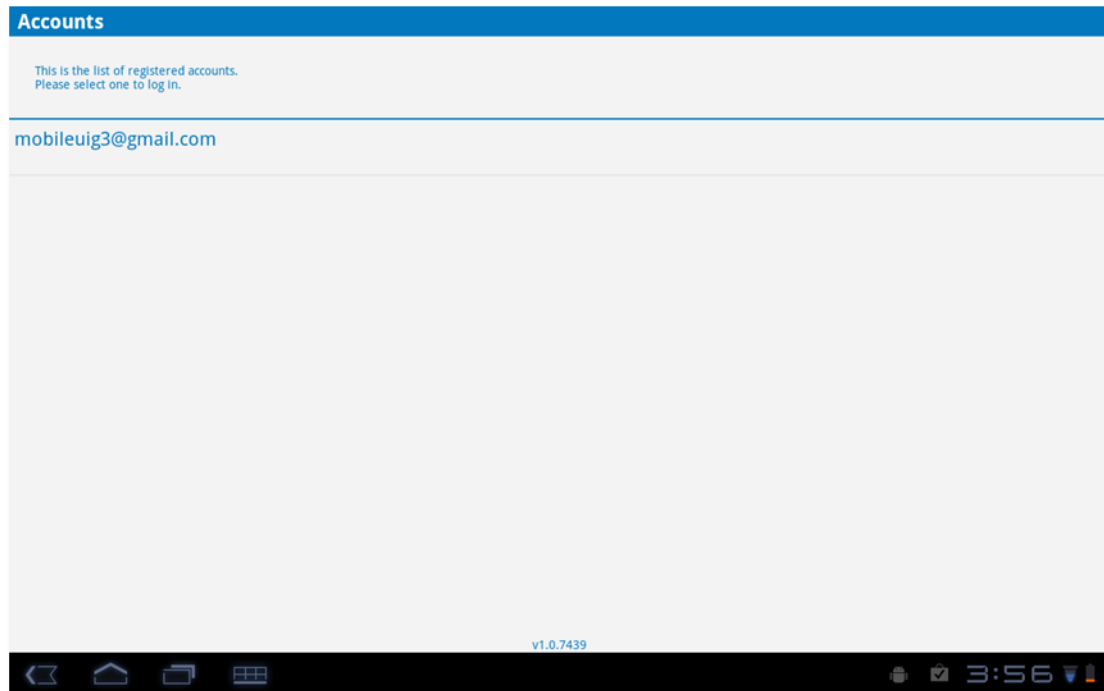
### **Hardware Requirements in Mobile Equipment**

- A minimum of 1MB available disk space for YuuWaa installation and files.
- SD memory card.

## LAUNCHING YUUWAA

To start, launch the YuuWaa application from your Home screen. The list of user accounts is displayed in **Accounts**.

**Note:** The first time you launch YuuWaa, you will be prompted to create an account to login to YuuWaa.

For more information about using YuuWaa, click **Help** from YuuWaa's home page.

### Logging into an Account

Before you can access the features provided by YuuWaa, you have to login to YuuWaa. If you already have a YuuWaa online account, in **Accounts**, select a YuuWaa account to sign in using your email address and password. Otherwise, create an account if you do not have an existing account with YuuWaa. If you have forgotten your password, you may reset the password by entering the email address which you used to connect to YuuWaa.

## Creating a YuuWaa Account

To create your YuuWaa account, select your country of residence, enter your email, choose a password, select the **Terms and Conditions** check box and click **OK**.

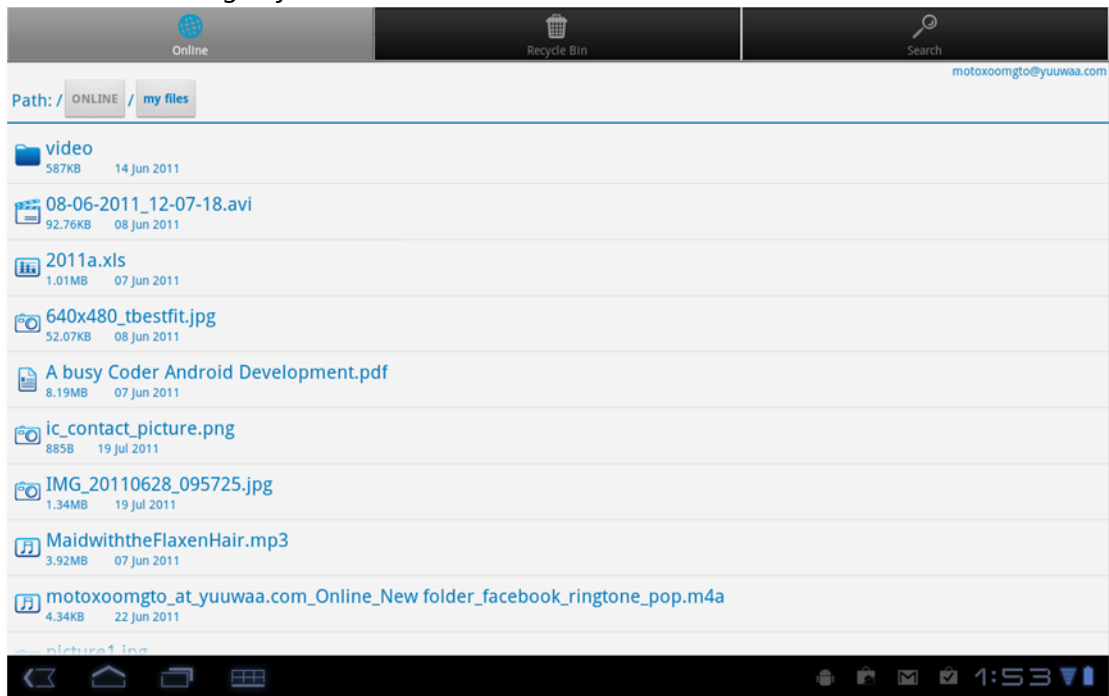
### Note:

- The password must contain a minimum of four characters.
- It is not possible to create another account if you have created it once on the same mobile equipment. However, you may add up to a maximum of five users to the YuuWaa application.

Once your account has been created, the credentials are automatically stored in the device's memory for future logins.

After a successful login to YuuWaa, the following screen will be displayed showing the list of files or folders that are uploaded previously.

You can start using the functions available in YuuWaa to:

- Search for files
- Upload files
- Create folders
- Share files among your contacts

With YuuWaa, it is easy to navigate within the folder structure and searching for files by its filename. You may switch between the different tabs—Online, Recycle Bin and Search to a different path at anytime.

There are option menus containing functions that are available to the current screen of the application such as **Upload**, **Create**, **Sort**, **Main menu**, **Refresh** and **My account**.

## ACCESSING THE CONTEXTUAL MENUS

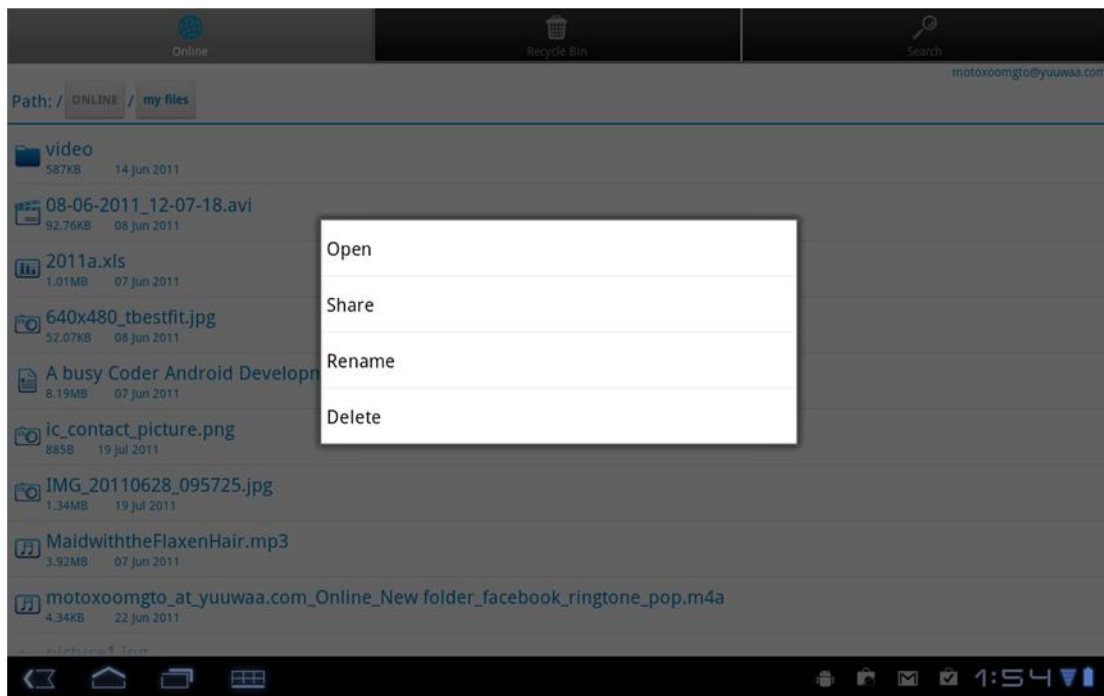
Depending on the item that you have selected and the path you are in, the following functions are available in the contextual menus.

### Opening a File/Folder

You can tap the folder to browse the folder contents. Touch and hold a file to activate the contextual menu options to open, rename or delete the folders you want to work with at the folder level. There is an option for file sharing if you are at the file level.

The **Path** specifies the levels of an item in the folder structure. The first level of the folder structure is indicated by the term “Online”.

### Viewing a File

Depending on the applications installed in your mobile equipment, you can view the files selected by tapping on it, or touch and hold a file to activate the contextual menu to open. While YuuWaa may have supported the media formats required, the viewing of file is also dependent on the media type supported by the media player.

Typically, most Android equipments come with audio players, video players and image viewers.

You can open the image files in the slideshow mode via tapping one of the image files. The slideshow displays the images that are stored in the current folder in which you tapped. You can swipe or use the arrow buttons to browse the images back and forth in the folder. To start the slideshow, tap once on the image to display the **Play** button and tap the **Play** button.

### **Renaming a File/Folder**

You may update the name of an existing folder or file with a new one by performing a touch and hold action on the selected item and select **Rename** from the contextual menu.

### **Delete a File/Folder**

At anytime, you may delete a folder or file that you no longer require in the **Online** folder by performing a touch and hold action on the selected item and select **Delete** from the contextual menu.

### **Sharing a File**

File sharing is one of the reasons for storing files in the virtual space. Select a file to be shared, touch and hold the screen to activate the contextual menu and select **Share** to add the selected contacts to access your file. In addition, you may add a password to encrypt the data you sent.

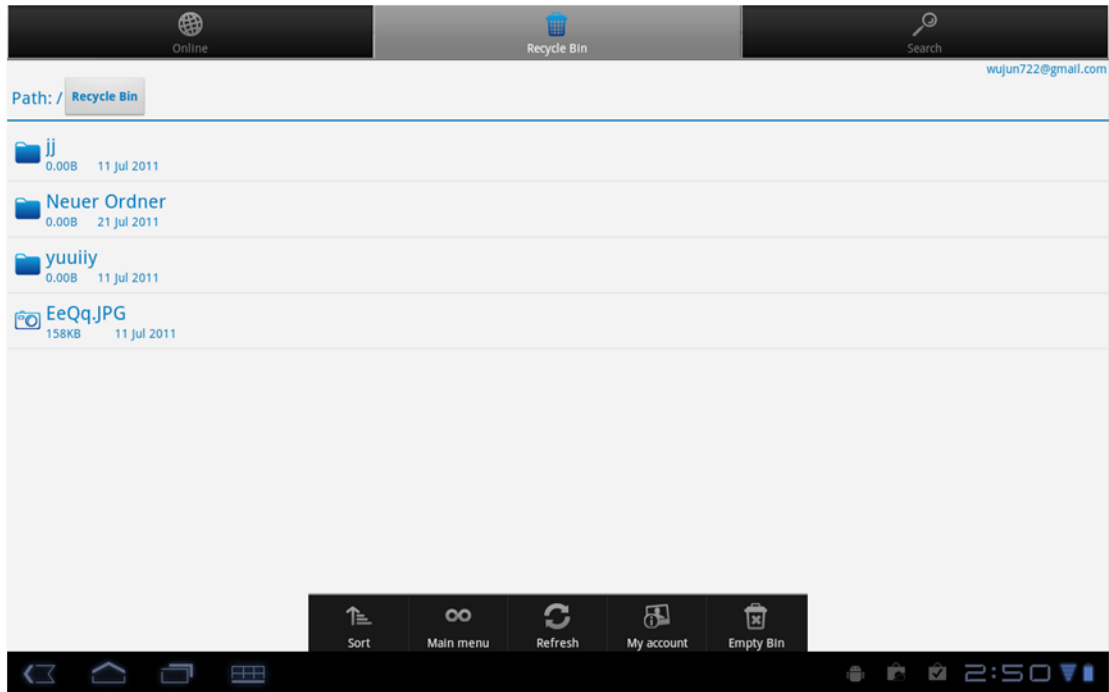
#### **Note:**

- Sharing can only be done at the file level. You cannot share a folder.
- Files located in the **Recycle Bin** path cannot be shared.

## ACCESSING THE OPTION MENUS

Depending on the folder structure level you are at, the following functions are available in the option menus. Option menus are located in one of the physical buttons on your mobile equipment. Tap the option menus button to access the menu items.

### Upload

When you are connected to YuuWaa, you can upload the files to the virtual space. You can also capture a photo or a video and upload it immediately.

### Create folder

You can create folders to organize your files into different topics so that it is easier to locate the files the next time you need them.

### Sort

Files and folders can be sorted according to their file names, type, date updated or size to facilitate for easy search.

### Main menu

Selecting this option takes you back to the main screen of YuuWaa.



## Refresh


This option updates the current screen to reflect the latest data if modifications such as deletions and adding of files have been made.



## My account

Displays the current user account and the amount of free space remaining in the storage server.

## CLEARING THE RECYCLE BIN

You can remove the files or folders that reside in your trash bin via the  on the Options menu when you are in the Recycle Bin path.

## YUUWAA ONLINE SERVICES

You can easily access your online data from your computer at <http://www.yuuwaa.com> with your e-mail and password that you used to access your YuuWaa account.

## APPLICATION UPDATE

Whenever you launch the YuuWaa application, the application will automatically check whether there is an update available for loading. If an update is available, you will be prompted to load the updates.

There are two types of updates—major update and minor update. For a major update, you must perform the download, otherwise the YuuWaa application will not work. If it is a minor update, you can choose to ignore the update and continue using the YuuWaa application. You will be prompted to do the updates to your application version again the next time you launch YuuWaa application.
